



POWERWASHING - A battery charger is an electrical appliance. Like most other electrical appliances, it is best that a battery charger avoids contact with water. Some equipment with on-board (sometimes referred to as built-in) chargers require cleaning with power washing equipment. Taking a moment to place a garbage bag over the charger prior to washing will help avoid potential problems down the road.

If your charger does happen to get wet, the best way to handle is to not use it for about a week. This time will allow the internal components to dry out and reduce the chances of an electrical short.
