Lester Electrical has considered the initiative to ban what are called “Conflict Minerals” or 3TG (Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten and Gold). This was brought about by the passage of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act in 2011. Lester Electrical is not directly subject to the requirements of this law. Companies who are subject to the law are required to contact their suppliers to determine whether any of these “Minerals” originate in the “Conflict” areas in Africa.

Current Minerals Used In Manufacturing

Lester Electrical currently uses Tantalum, Tin and Gold in the manufacture of our Battery Charger products.

Continued Monitoring

Lester Electrical will continue to monitor and perform a reasonable due diligence within its supply chain to ensure that the minerals used in our products are not procured as “Conflict Minerals”.
